Stalls: \$35.00 **Erie Co. Ag. Society prohibits showing off trailers**

Shavings: \$8.00 per bag

Fees:

Package Deal \$125.00 includes 1 stall (Thursday and Friday) and all Open classes Does Not include AQHA classes.

All individual classes, including AQHA Novice and Rookie classes: \$10.00

Champion & Reserve ribbons for all divisions

Walk/Trot riders: may only show in Walk/Trot classes or Halter classes.

Youth: Must be under 16 yrs. of age as of Jan. 1 this year, minimum age 6 years

Adult: Any rider over age 16 yrs. of age

Youth classes are all age unless designated, then age is determined as of Jan. 1, 2016.

Current Negative Coggins (this year or last) required.

Points are kept on one rider/one horse combination.

Show management and Erie Co. Fairgrounds reserve the right to excuse unruly or dangerous horses.

WNYQHCI and Erie Co. Ag. Society is not responsible for accidents or loss to horse, rider, personal property or spectators.

It is recommended that all youth riders 18 & under wear an ASTM or SEI approved helmet while mounted.
